

HLF Facts

- Awards for All-awards up to £5000
 - Young Roots-awards up to £25,000
 - Your Heritage-awards up to £50,000
 - Heritage Grants-awards over £50,000
 - Project planning grants-awards up to £50,000
-
- Major grants team deals with projects over £5 million
 - Your Heritage grants decisions mostly delegated to regional and country team grants officers
 - 12 Regional/ country committees decide on grants under £2m
 - Grants over £2m are decided by our Board of Trustees
 - Smaller UK wide projects can also go to Board.

HLF Facts

- Each team consists of grants officers, casework managers, development teams, Young Roots co-ordinators and a regional manager
- Each regional team has its own committee except major grants
- There is one expert panel which meets in London every quarter
- Advice can be sought from special external advisors, expert panel members, committee members, trustees and policy members.

Partnership Funding

Grants of between £2 million and £5 million

Minimum partnership contribution of 25% but applicants should do better where possible

Budget under increasing pressure, and subject to a competitive process

Major Grants of over £5 million

The pressure on this budget has caused the Trustees to raise the minimum level of partnership funding required

- 35% for grant applications of £5m to £10m
- 50% for grant applications of £10m and over
